Catching Up:

- There has been no movement on the cell tower variance submitted to the Town Zoning Board in April by New Cingular Wireless, a subsidiary of AT&T. Town engineers are still reviewing their application, as well as the proposal submitted for Prospect Hill. These are the only variances submitted to date in Guilderland.
- Since about the same amount of work is needed to do an "interim" *Directory*, the Board instead voted to have a full, revised directory printed this fall.

Looking Forward:

- The Labor Day Picnic, held at the common grounds on Walnut Lane, is an excellent opportunity for new residents to get to know each other. So, if you are new to Covington Woods in the last couple of years, do make plans to attend.
